

- The participants to the Q4 2019 call expressed their satisfaction regarding the creation and the development of the U.S. chapter. They gave kudos to its leadership on the actions that have been accomplished so far.
- They confirmed their interest in the ongoing actions, and made suggestions that will be taken into consideration for the 2020 action plan (see "To Do List").
- They asked if it would make sense to turn the U.S. chapter into a non-for-profit registered in the U.S. The Chair explained that this option was considered in 2016, but was not pursued to keep the administration of the chapter simple for now. However, if we keep growing and start working on more complex operations (e.g. organizing events) a registration on our own could be necessary.
- At the suggestion of the Chair, the participants confirmed the principle of a vote online to let all the members express their opinion on the leadership of the chapter and the 2020 action plan.
