



OPERATIONAL OBJECTIVES (+2 YEARS)



How can we translate the strategic goals into objectives we can implement over the next 12-24 months?

What activities and programs should we roll out?

Define as many operational objectives as needed for the months to come.

Examples: Organize quarterly calls, organize at least 4 local afterworks, sponsor at least 2 ENAC Alumni webinars, develop a guidance on local licenses and certifiations, disseminate alumni news and job opportunities (newsletter).

001	Organize local afterwork events
002	Disseminate alumni news, job opportunities, events (newsletter)
003	Organize quarterly calls for group updates
004	Organize other type of meetings: Roundtable, Working Groups, Thematic Task Force, Think Tank, Workshop
005	Keep the Chapter member contact details up-to-date and develop a welcoming guidance document for ENAC alumni or ENAC students who freshly arrived in Canada



★ 2024-2025 ACTION PLAN

How can we reach our objectives through practical actions?

What can we do this year?

Define as many practical actions as needed for this year.

Examples: Schedule and run quarterly calls, organize local afterworks around specific dates and locations, sponsor ENAC Alumni webinars on topics A and B, write draft guidance on local licenses and certifications, send alumni news newsletter every X months.
