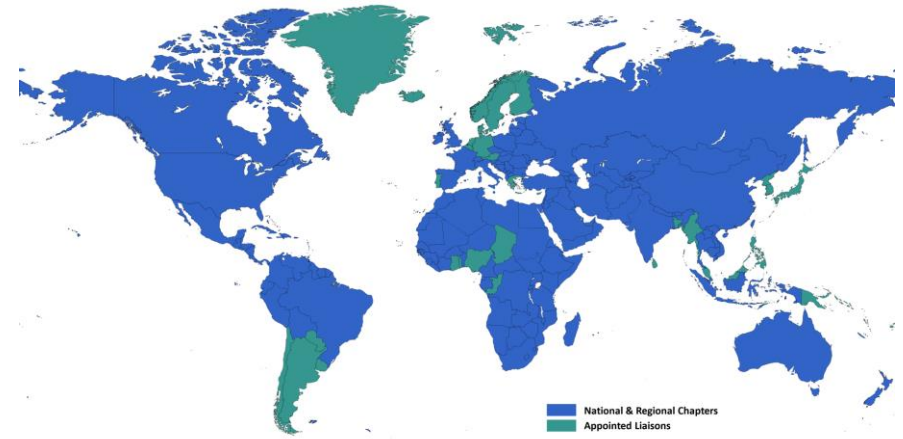

ABOUT ENAC ALUMNI

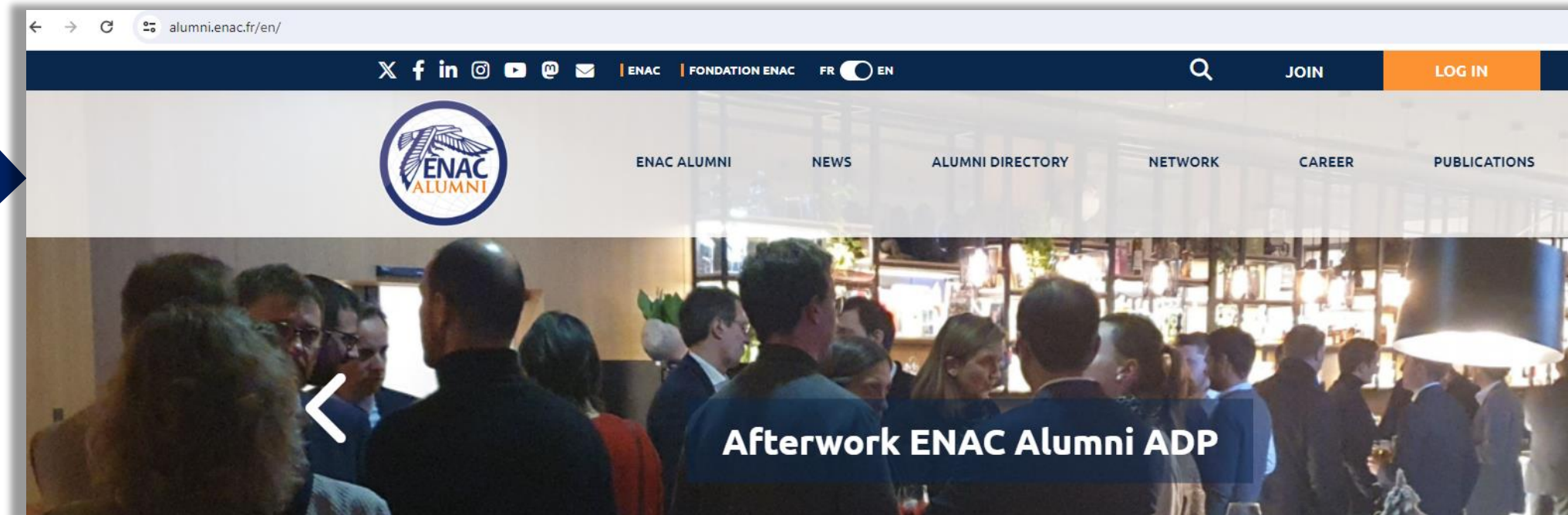
- ENAC Alumni is a nonprofit organization that brings together and supports the broader alumni community of ENAC.

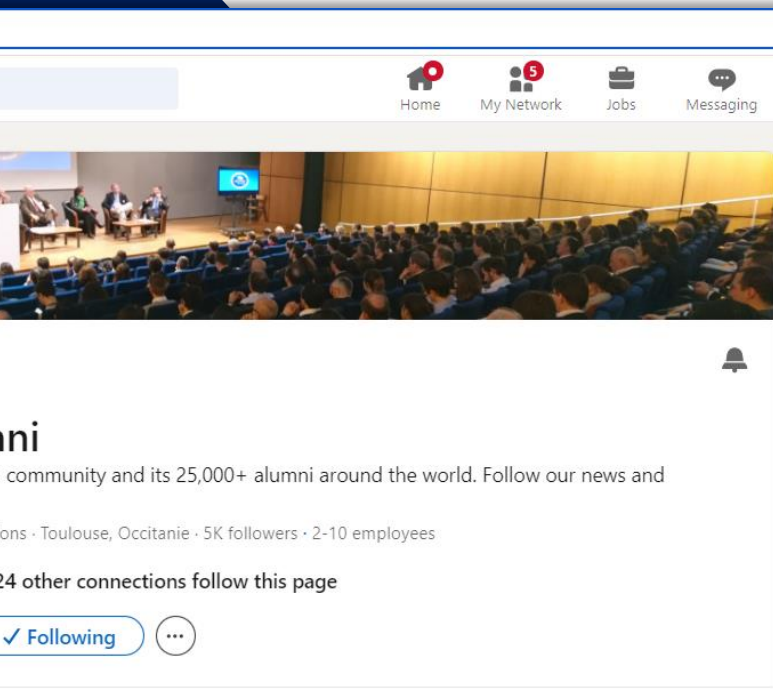

IESF is the association of the Engineers and Scientists of France. Each year, IESF conducts a survey to capture the state of the engineering community.

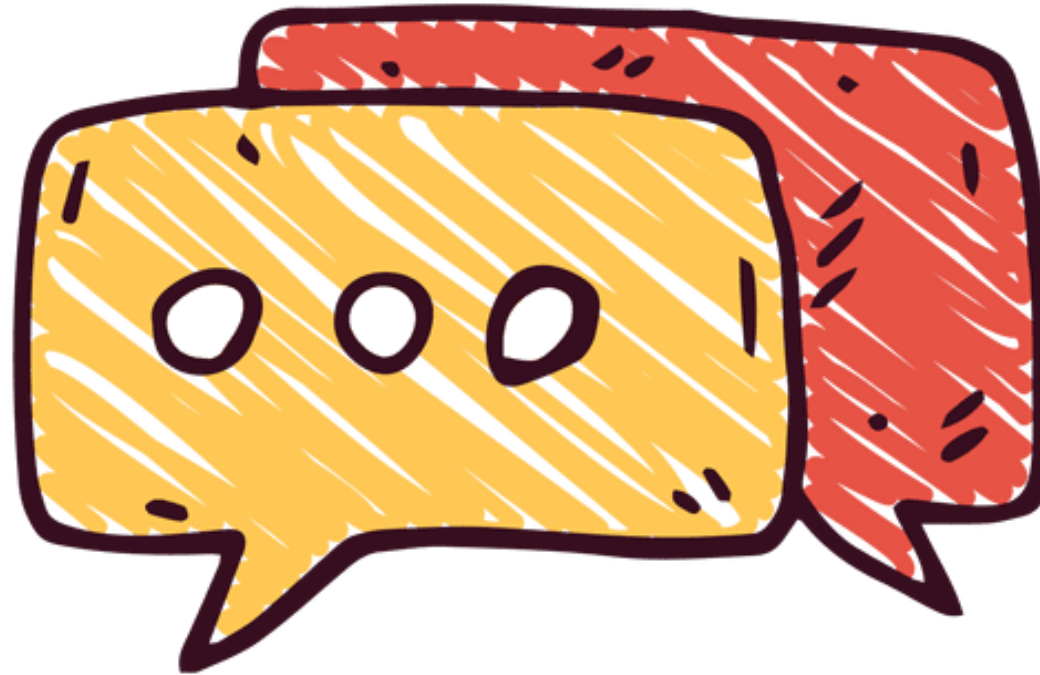
All ENAC Alumni are invited to take the survey – you don't need to work in engineering today, or to hold an IENAC degree specifically, to do so.
